



## **Replacement project along section of Virginia Drive beginning March 27**

Beginning March 27, Toho Water Authority will begin conducting a water line replacement project along the south side of Virginia Dr. between Phillips St. and N. Catherine St. The project is expected to be completed in approximately three months. Schedules could vary according to weather and other unforeseen circumstances. Crews will be working in front yards. Yard restoration will be carried out as the project progresses. Any disturbed areas will be returned as closely as possible to their pre-construction condition.

Motorists are urged to use caution when approaching these areas as workers will be present.
