Pursuant to Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, the public is hereby advised that: If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Committee with respect to any matter considered at this meeting, that person will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose that person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made. , which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
