Temporary road closure on Remington Blvd between Parkland Square and Windsor Park Subdivisions

Kissimmee, Fla., August 2018 - Toho Water Authority is announcing the closure to thru-traffic at the intersection of Remington Boulevard between Parkland Square and Windsor Park Subdivisions. This temporary closure is due to a repair of a collapsed manhole. The schedule shown below is conservative and tries to take into account unforeseen weather and conditions typical of underground construction projects.

Remington Blvd between Parkland Square and Windsor Park Subdivisions

Road closure duration: Approx. three months

- Intersection is closed to thru-traffic. Detour signs have been put in place to guide residents in and out of both subdivisions.

Motorists are urged to use caution when approaching these areas, as workers will be present and speed limits may be reduced in certain areas.
