IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Update: Levels of TTHMs are within compliance in recent quarter monitoring

November 2020

Dear Lake Ajay Village residents –

In May 2020, Toho Water Authority (Toho) sent Lake Ajay Village residents a public notice update regarding the elevated levels of Total Trihalomethanes, or TTHMs, a category of disinfection by-products.

We are pleased to inform that our recent quarterly sampling conducted for TTHMs during the 4th week of October 2020, resulted in a running annual average of 60.33 ppb. Per the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) requirements, this running annual average falls within the Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) of 80 parts per billion (ppb). The Lake Ajay Water System is now fully compliant.

Our commitment

Toho will continue to monitor for disinfection by-products and report the results to you should they exceed their MCL. In addition, Toho is working with the City of St. Cloud to monitor operations and make adjustments as necessary to minimize the formation of TTHMs. Toho is also adding pipelines and a water plant in this area to further improve water quality and redundancy.

Please share this information with all people who drink the water in the community, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
