**Part of East Magnolia Street to close for sewer rehabilitation project**

**Kissimmee, Fla. (Friday, April 22, 2022)** – Toho Water Authority is announcing that a portion of East Magnolia Street will be closed to thru traffic beginning Monday, April 25, for sewer rehabilitation work.

The closure is between US 192 and North Carson Avenue (please see map). Detour signage will be in place to direct motorists around the work zone. The road is expected to reopen Friday, April 28. Schedules may vary according to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

Motorists and pedestrians are urged to use caution when approaching this area, as workers will be present and speed limits may be reduced and sidewalks possibly closed and diverted. Signage is in place to keep the traveling public informed of the project.
