**Parts of East Cherry, Bay, Royal streets to close for sewer rehabilitation project**

**Kissimmee, Fla. (Monday, May 2, 2022)** – Toho Water Authority is announcing that a portion of East Magnolia Street will be closed to thru traffic beginning Tuesday, May 3, for sewer rehabilitation work.

The following segments of road will be affected by the closure:

- East Cherry Street, between Royal Street and North Brack Street
- Royal Street, between US 192 and East Cherry Street
- Bay Street, between US 192 and East Cherry Street

Detour signage will be in place to direct motorists around the work zone. All three roads are expected to reopen Friday, May 6. Schedules may vary according to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

Motorists and pedestrians are urged to use caution when approaching this area, as workers will be present and speed limits may be reduced and sidewalks possibly closed and diverted. Signage is in place to keep the traveling public informed of the project.
