Ivy Mist Lane and Old Tampa Hwy area service disruption/precautionary boil water advisory

6.29.26 – Toho Water Authority (Toho) customers located in the following areas will experience a disruption of their water service starting at 8 a.m. on Monday, June 29 (see map below):

- 6605-6624 Ivy Mist Lane
- 6680, 6678, 6676 and 6674 Old Tampa Hwy

This interruption of service is necessary to conduct maintenance activities at the water treatment facility. Service is expected to be restored by 2 p.m. Schedules may change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Once service is restored, customers are advised as a precautionary measure to boil their water for one minute prior to consumption (drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth or washing dishes). This includes filtered water. As an alternative bottled water may be used. Water used for laundry or bathing/showering does not need to be boiled.

The precautionary boil water advisory will be in effect until lifted by Toho.

Once service is restored, a two-day minimum of regulatory testing is required to make sure the water meets drinking water standards. An update will be provided by Wednesday, July 1.
