

# Toho Water Southwest WTP Upgrades



## What This Project Brings to Our Community

We're excited to start improvements to the **Southwest Water Treatment Plant**! These upgrades will enhance overall operations, boost system reliability, and continue delivering high-quality drinking water to our community. As part of this project, we are installing an advanced forced-draft aeration system to effectively remove hydrogen sulfide (that slight rotten egg smell) along with a modern odor control system.

This two-phased effort will boost our daily water supply and, eventually, carefully treat water directly from Shingle Creek. Once fully complete, the facility will be able to supply up to **six million gallons of drinking water every day!**

## How this benefits our community

- **Advanced Water Treatment:** Installation of a forced-draft aeration system to remove hydrogen sulfide (which causes that "rotten egg" smell) so our water always smells as delicious as it tastes
- **Odor Control:** A new odor control system captures and treats the hydrogen sulfide once it's removed before it's harmlessly released into the atmosphere
